This order will dispose of two petitions filed by the petitioner, one **CRM-M-35437 of 2014 and the other CRM-M-14229 of 2015** in same case bearing FIR No. 3 dated 03.01.2014 registered at Police Station Tarn Taran under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, for bail under Section 167 (2) Cr.P.C. and 439 Cr.P.C, respectively.

The petitioner had been granted the concession of interim bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court on 12.05.2015 in CRM-M-35437 of 2014. It is a case of no recovery. There appears to be no ground to recall order dated 12.05.2015, especially when challan has already been presented and even charges have been framed.

The petition bearing No. CRM-M-35437 of 2014 is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner will remain on bail against the bail bonds already furnished subject to the condition that he will not hamper the expeditious disposal of the trial and continue to appear before the trial Court.

Since the petitioner has been granted bail in petition CRM-M-35437 of 2014, the second petition CRM-M-14229 of 2015 has rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
