The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.61,
dated 12.4.2015, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, at Police
Station Division No.5, Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the recovery in
this case is of 120 grams Alprazolam which is marginally above the
commercial quantity and the petitioner has been in custody for more than

eight months.

Custody certificate has been filed, as per which the petitioner has undergone 8 months and 11 days of custody.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
