In FIR No.1 dated 01.01.2016, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 61 of the Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station City Palwal, the petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail.

This Court had made an order dated October 07, 2016 directing the State counsel to find out whether any other case has been pending against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State upon instructions from ASI, Dharmpal, fairly states that there is no other case is pending against the petitioner. The petitioner is in illicit/illegal possession of the liquor bottles.

This appears to be the first offence against the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, the petitioner is granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail.

In the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail in FIR No.1 dated 01.01.2016, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 61 of the Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station City Palwal, on furnishing of his bail bond amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer concerned. The petitioner shall, however, join the investigation and fully cooperate with the Investigating Officer.
