Report dated 25.02.2016 sent by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Kuljit Singh, Manish @ Mani, Ravi Kumar @ Happy, Sucha Singh, Mohit as well as of complainant Baljit Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is pure business dispute and that the parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not of heinous nature which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.124 dated 03.08.2010 under Section 365 IPC Police Station, Model Town Hoshiarpur and all other consequential

proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
