ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

Counsel for the petitioner on the last date had sought time to take instructions. Today he states that petitioner has not contacted him nor he is able to contact her and wants to withdraw the petition.

Counsel for respondent no.2 states that petition cannot be permitted to be withdrawn as this Court had directed the petitioner to approach the summoning Court and thereafter, her appearance was to be exempted. Counsel has placed on record the

zimni orders to show that the petitioner did not appear before the Court below and they were insisting that their presence had been exempted.

The order dated 04.12.2015, passed by the co-ordinate Bench was clear. The petitioner has been summoned in a complaint case. She is resident of Canada. She was asked to appear before the summoning Court and seek bail and thereafter, her appearance was to be exempted till further orders. The petitioner had failed to appear before the trial Court and has failed to comply with the orders.

The petition is dismissed.
