JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 to 5 to register FIR against respondents No. 6 to 9 and their accomplices with regard to murder of husband of petitioner.

2. Notice to respondents No.2 to 5, only at this stage.
3. At the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. It has been *inter-alia* contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that though representation dated November 17, 2015 (Annexure P-1) was moved to respondents and statements of Rajveer Kaur as well as that of brother of the deceased have been recorded by the police but till date no action has been taken.

5. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5- Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot to look into the grievances of the petitioner unfolded by her in her representation dated November 17, 2015 (Annexure P-1) and if found necessary, take appropriate measures in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
