The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.94,
dated 16.9.2016, registered under Sections 308, 452, 323, 341, 506, 148,
149 of the IPC, at Police Station Barnala, District Barnala.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has
been in custody since 16.9.2016 and the matter has now been settled and
the other co-accused have not so far been arrested.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from HC Sher

Singh, has not denied the factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.
