Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to investigate the case FIR No. 127 dated June 02, 2015 under Section 17 of NDPS Act, Police Station Division No. 8, Jalandhar in a fair and impartial manner with further direction to respondent No.2 to transfer the investigation of the case to some higher police official not below the rank of Superintendent of Police.

2. In pursuance of notice of motion issued by this Court, official respondents filed reply in the shape of an affidavit of Balwinder Iqbal Singh

Kahlon, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (North), Jalandhar.

3. A perusal of reply transpires that after completion of investigation report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. has already been presented against the petitioner on September 28, 2015 and after framing the charge now the trial is fixed for prosecution evidence.

4. In view of the afore-said facts and circumstances, instant petition has rendered infructuous and is disposed of, as such.

5. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved, he can have recourse to the other remedies available to him under law.
