In FIR No.35 dated 10.02.2014 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala, District Patiala, the petitioners are being prosecuted.

Now, the complainant as well as the petitioners have entered into compromise. There is a prayer for allowing the parties to compound/compromise the offence(s) registered in FIR.

This Court vide order dated September 07, 2015 had directed

the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate to record the statements of the parties. Accordingly, a report has been received District & Sessions Judge, Patiala, showing that the statements of the parties have been recorded and compromise that is arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In that view of the matter, FIR No.35 dated 10.02.2014 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala, District Patiala is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
