With the assistance of learned State counsel, I have gone through the police record, brought by ASI Nirmal Singh. A perusal of the police file indicates that the petitioner has been attributed a *kirpan* blow, hitting the frontal side of the left leg of the complainant, namely Raj Balbir Singh. The injury attributed to the petitioner is grievous in nature. X-ray report of the complainant indicates that the bone cut is attributed to the petitioner on the frontal bone.

There appears to be a rivalry between the parties as father of the petitioner has lodged an FIR under Section 420 I.P.C., against Raj Balbir Singh, the complainant. A similar type of grievous injury is

alleged to have been received by the father of the petitioner, regarding which a cross-version has been recorded.

In view of the abovesaid circumstances, the petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that he will join the investigation as and when required by the police and will not, in any manner, make any attempt to tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation and will not indulge in similar activities during pendency of the trial.
