Ritu Bahri, J.

In view of the fact that the trial is at the stage of recording of prosecution evidence, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition with liberty to take all the pleas before the trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

However, personal appearance of petitioner Nos. 1 and 2 (Kanta Rani and Ramesh Pal) before the trial Court is exempted subject to the following conditions:-

(i) they shall be represented through counsel; (ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings; (iii) shall not dispute their identity as accused: (iv) shall have no objection if, the prosecution evidence is recorded in their absence, but in the presence of their counsel; (v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required; and (vi) any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.
