Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.30 dated 31.03.2016, under Sections 363 and 366-A IPC, registered at Police Station Kanwan, District Pathankot, on the basis of compromise dated 29.09.2016 (Annexure P-2).

Brief facts of the case are that on 30.03.2016 daughter of the complainant had gone to the shop of Chemist for bringing medicine for her grandmother but she had not come back. Subsequently, the complainant has lodged the present FIR on the basis of suspicion that some unknown boy has enticed her with the intention of marrying her.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the peace and harmony, the matter has now been amicably settled between the parties with the intervention of respectable persons and relatives, vide compromise deed dated 29.09.2016 (Annexure P-2).

During the course of preliminary hearing, the trial Court, was directed to record the statements of all the concerned parties, with regard to the genuineness and validity or otherwise of the compromise dated 29.09.2016 (Annexure P-2), by way of order dated 07.10.2016, by this Court.

In compliance of order dated 07.10.2016 of this Court, the report of the Additional Sessions Judge, Pathankot, dated 01.12.2016 has been received. As per the report, the statements of all the concerned parties have been recorded and the complainant has no objection, if the present FIR registered against the petitioner is quashed. Statements of the petitioner and complainant have been recorded to the same effect.

Consequently, in view of the above-said report and in view of the judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Dr. Arvind Barsaul etc. Vs. State of Madhya Pradesh and another, 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 910; Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab, 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429** and the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Kulwinder Singh and Ors. vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.30 dated 31.03.2016, under Sections 363 and 366-A IPC, registered at Police Station Kanwan, District Pathankot and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed, on the basis of compromise dated 29.09.2016 (Annexure P-2).

The present petition stands disposed of.
