The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.87 dated 07.09.2016 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 323, 336 & 34 IPC 1860, Sections 3 & 4 of SC & ST Act 1989 and Section 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur in view of the compromise (Annexure P-2).

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No2/complainant submits that compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had made order dated 07.10.2016 asking for recording of statement in order to find out the correctness and genuineness of the compromise said to have been arrived at between the parties.

Accordingly statements have been recorded by the trial Court and report has been received by this Court through the District and Sessions Judge, Ferozepur. Perusal of the report shows that the compromise is genuine and without any pressure. I have seen the offences registered against the petitioners. Looking to the nature of the offence I think the compromise/compounding should be allowed.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-36329 OF 2016 is allowed.
- (ii) FIR No.87 dated 07.09.2016 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 323, 336 & 34 IPC 1860, Sections 3 & 4 of SC & ST Act 1989 and Section 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur, is quashed qua the petitioners along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
