The petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Ranjeet Singh alleging that the complainant has been duped of a sum of ₹18,00,000/- on the pretext of sending him abroad. His passport and other documents had been taken but later on neither his amount was returned nor he was sent abroad. The allegation against the petitioner is that he had taken a sum of ₹5,00,000/- on 26.09.2015 and 2 days thereafter telephonically demanded sum of ₹2,62,000/- for immigration purposes which was deposited in the account of co-accused Ravi Kant. The said amount was allegedly withdrawn by the petitioner through ATM.

Challan has already been presented. Petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 22.12.2015 and the trial is likely to take a long time. Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
