The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR  
No.115, dated 27.8.2015, registered under Sections 420, 120-B of the  
IPC, at Police Station Raja Sansi, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has got  
another sum of ₹ 70,000/- in cash and the same has been handed over to

counsel for the complainant.

It is now admitted that out of ₹ 4 lacs, only ₹ 30,000/- remain to be paid which counsel for the petitioner states will be paid within 15 days. Let the petitioner appear before the IO on 2.9.2016 and hand over the remaining amount of ₹ 30,000/-, by way of demand draft in favour of the complainant. In that event, the Investigating Officer will confirm the interim bail granted to the petitioner to his satisfaction and hand over the demand draft to the complainant. This petition stands disposed of. It is, however, made clear that if the amount is not deposited, the present petition will be deemed to be dismissed.
