Complainant Dharminder Sondhi, on account of injuries inflicted upon him by assailants on 17.09.2015 allegedly by Karan Dutta and his accomplices lodged an FIR No.115 dated 17.09.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 307, 382, 323, 324, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code read with Section 25 & 27 of the Arms Act registered with Police Station Division No.4, Jalandhar (P-1).

By way of the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC he is praying for issuance of directions to the Police Authorities to arrest the persons as named in his subsequent complaint/representation dated 28.09.2015 (P-2) addressed to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar.

Further direction is for monitoring the investigation by this Court.

Upon notice reply of ACP Central, Jalandhar has been filed wherein it is averred that upon investigation the principle accused Karan Dutta named in the eye witness account of the complainant has been found innocent. The efforts qua arrest of the remaining accused are being sincerely made. He further points out that as per the affidavit dated 12.01.2016 of the complainant some of the named accused as per Annexure **P-2** have been stated to be not involved as per the revised version of the complainant himself.

Faced with this situation, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
