Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
for quashing of FIR No.121 dated 07.12.2012, under Sections 498-A and
406 IPC, registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar City, Punjab.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel intends to
withdraw the present petition to enable the petitioners to take all the pleas
contained in it before the trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn, as prayed for.

However, the personal presence of the petitioners is exempted
before the trial Court, subject to the following conditions:- (i) petitioners

shall be represented through counsel; (ii) shall not delay/stall the trial

proceedings; (iii) shall not dispute their identity as accused: (iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in their absence but in the presence of their counsel; (v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court; and (vi) any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.
