AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

On 21.10.2016 the following order was passed :-

“This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.130 dated 06.10.2014 registered under Sections 302/201/34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Mohana, Sonapat, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody for more than 2 years and the 02 material witnesses have turned hostile.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on the other hand states that only 04 witnesses remain to be examined and in case the petitioner does not obstruct the trial the prosecution will lead its entire evidence by 30.11.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same) and seeks an adjournment to place on record affidavit of S.P. Sonapat.

Adjourned to 10.11.2016.”

Learned Additional Advocate General states that on the last date it was inadvertently mentioned that the case was fixed for 30.11.2016 whereas it was fixed for 03.11.2016 on that date the Court was on leave and the matter has been adjourned to 12.12.2016.

Today the affidavit of Hardeep Singh Doon, S.P. Sonapat on behalf of the respondent-State has been filed and the same is taken on record, as per which the prosecution undertakes to conclude its entire evidence on or before 12.12.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same).

In the circumstances, the present petition is dismissed. In view of this undertaking it is directed that in case the prosecution does not conclude its evidence in the manner indicated above, the Court shall release the petitioner on bail on 12.12.2016 to its satisfaction.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
