Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to the respondents No.1 and 2 to hand over the enquiry and investigation into the representations made by the petitioner to the CBI, Chandigarh or any other independent agency.

This Court vide order dated 23.9.2015, disposed of Criminal Misc. No. M-32545 of 2015 titled as 'Vineet Sood and others vs. State of Punjab and others' with the following observations :-

“Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to hand over the enquiry and investigation into the representations made by the petitioners to the CBI, Chandigarh or any other independent agency.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali is directed to look into the representation dated 3.6.2015 (Annexure P-1) and to take appropriate action as warranted by law, expeditiously.

Disposed of.”

Taking into consideration the similar relief claimed in the present petition as in CRM-M-32545 of 2015, the present petition is disposed with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali to look into the representation dated 3.6.2015 (Annexure P-1) and to take appropriate action as warranted by law, expeditiously.
