The petitioners have filed instant applications for being enlarged on anticipatory bail being wanted in case FIR No. 90 dated 24.09.2016, registered under Sections 447, 511, 379, 506, 294, 427, 148, 149, 120-B IPC at Police Station Naya Gaon, District Mohali.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1- Sukha Singh (in CRM M No. 36501 of 201) has since been arrested by the police and therefore the present application qua him has become infructuous. Ordered accordingly.

As regards petitioners No. 1 to 4 namely, Angrej Singh, Lakha Singh, Hardial Singh and Rana Singh (in CRM-M No. 36495 of 2016) learned counsel submits that the petitioners are ready to surrender before the learned Area Magistrate but their application for regular bail be decided by the learned Area Magistrate at the earliest.

Petitioner No. 5 namely, Mata Singh (in CRM-M No.

36495 of 2016) is a person shown to be aged 68 years and petitioner No.3 namely, Pakhar Singh (in CRM-M No. 36501 of 2016) is said to be 80 years old. As per the medical record produced, petitioner-Pakhar Singh was admitted in PGI on 12.05.2016 and was under regular treatment till 06.06.2016. Petitioner No. 2 Balak Singh (in CRM-M No. 36501 of 2016) is said to be a Government employee, posted as Mali with Horticulture Department, Chandigarh Administration.

The petitioners namely, Mata Singh, Pakhar Singh and Balak Singh are directed to join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they be admitted to bail by the arresting officer to his satisfaction. Thereafter, they will appear before the learned Area Magistrate within 30 days and will be enlarged on regular bail on their furnishing Bonds to the satisfaction of the Area Magistrate.

Considering the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner(s), the present petition filed on behalf of petitioners namely Angrej Singh, Lakha Singh, Hardial Singh and Rana Singh (in CRM-M No. 36495 of 2016) is dismissed as withdrawn. In case they surrender before the Area Magistrate within 3 days the application for regular bail filed by them shall be decided within 3 days.
