By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 142 dated 06.11.2013, registered under Sections 323, 324 and 201 IPC, at Police Station Chajjli, District Sangrur.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

It has been averred in the petition that the parties have compromised the matter and a quashing petition on the basis of compromise has been filed wherein the parties were directed to get record their statements. The petitioner being pregnant could not appear before the trial Court and has been declared proclaimed

offender. The absence of petitioner is neither willful nor intentional.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application.

Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances of the case, it is ordered that in case the petitioner appears/surrenders before the trial Court, within a week from today, in that eventuality, she shall be admitted to bail on her furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
