Instant petition has been preferred by petitioners under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 44, dated 11.05.2013, under Section 435 IPC, registered at Police Station Julkan, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners feels satisfied in case a direction is given to Investigating Agency through SSP that investigation be completed in a time bound manner.

During the investigation of the case, the allegations leveled by the complainant was found to be untrue as a result

whereof the cancellation report was prepared under Section 173 Cr.P.C. and was presented before trial Court on February 05, 2015. The complainant-respondent No.2 was served with a notice who has shown his disagreement with investigation conducted by police and also stated that he is not satisfied with the investigation. Vide order dated July 23, 2015, trial Court has ordered to re-investigate the matter and since then the matter is pending with the Investigating Agency. In this case, both the petitioners are students and they intend to go abroad for higher studies.

Taking into consideration, the aforesaid aspects of the case without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to SSP concerned to get investigation completed and proceed in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
