The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.208, dated 11.8.2016, registered under Sections 379, 411, 467, 468, 472, 473, 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has now been in custody for three months and seven days and the offences are trialable by the Magistrate. As per the FIR, the alleged stolen motor

cycle was being driven by one co-accused and its forged papers were recovered from another co-accused and no recovery has been made from the present petitioner.

Counsel for the respondent has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
