Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.204, dated 13.11.2015, under Section 324 IPC (Section 326 added later on), registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur,

The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner has inflicted an injury by a sharp edged weapon on the left side of the neck of the complainant. Though the complainant specifically states in the FIR that he recognises the petitioner, his Medical Legal Report annexed as Annexure P-2 shows that he was under the influence of liquor.

The petitioner has been in custody for about 3 ½ months. Even the charges have not been framed yet. The trial is likely to take some time.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, it is directed that the petitioner be admitted to bail subject to the satisfaction of the trial court.
