The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to respondents No. 3 and 4 for restraining them from pressurizing the petitioner and other Pws for affecting compromise with the accused persons in case First Information Report no. 208 dated 08.09.2016 under Sections, 307,323, 324, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25, 27 of the Arms Act (Sections 452 and 482 of the Indian Penal Code added later on) registered at Police Station Ramamandi Jalandhar with a further prayer that the investigating officer should record the statements of the petitioner and eye witness and for monitoring the investigation of the case.

S.I Naresh Kumar Joshi and ASI Daljinder Singh (respondents no. 3 and 4) are present in person. On instructions from respondents No. 3 and 4 learned State counsel submits that the statement of the petitioner as well as the witnesses under Section 161 Cr.P.C. were recorded much before

the present petition was filed. As per the First Information Report, there are three accused and all three have since been arrested and now final report is being prepared and will be presented in the trial Court for trial of the accused.

Considering the current status of the case intimated by learned State counsel, no further action in the present petition is required to be taken.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of.
