ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 129 dated 08.12.2015, registered under Sections 304-B/34 IPC, Police Station Julkan, District Patiala.

There are allegations of beatings against the husband, mother-in-law and the sister-in-law. The deceased had died of burn injuries. The incident had taken place in the courtyard, which is next to the kitchen. None of the family members made any attempt to save the girl. All the persons were named were present in the house. The incident took place at about 9:30 AM. The deceased was not taken to Rajindra Hospital, which is at a distance of 10 kilometers but she was taken to another hospital, which is more than 25 kilometers away. The allegations are serious. No case for anticipatory bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
