This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the respondents to get investigation of case FIR No.103 dated 25.09.2015 under Sections 406, 498A IPC, registered at Police Station Women Police, District Patiala, conducted from some independent agency or a senior police official outside the district Patiala for fair investigation.

On issuing notice, reply has been filed by DSP (Headquarters), Patiala on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. The same is taken on record.

As per reply, no case of maltreatment of the petitioner by her in-laws as disclosed by her before DSP (Headquarters) Patiala, has been found. On examination of call details of the mobile phone of the petitioner, it was found that she made more calls to Varinder (suspected person) than to her in-laws and continuously talked to him till late 12/1 in the night. The cancellation report has been prepared and on 28.04.2016 it was submitted

by the learned Illaqa Magistrate, Patiala for 02.11.2016 but the petitioner did not appear before him and now the case is fixed for 17.01.2017.

Keeping in view the above, the present petition is disposed of and application for impleading Amit Verma as respondent No.4 is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to appear before the trial Court on 17.01.2016 and take appropriate steps before the trial Court in accordance with law.
