Prayer in this application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for withdrawal of statement made by counsel for the petitioners on 17.10.2016 regarding undertaking of settling the outstanding amount with the respondent-complainant.

Learned counsel for the applicants-petitioners states that on 17.10.2016, he had made the statement presumably under the impression that he would be able to convince his clients, but since his clients have not agreed to said offer, he wishes to withdraw the said statement.

For the reasons stated in the application and after hearing learned counsel for the applicants-petitioners, the application is allowed and the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners on 17.10.2016 is

ordered to be withdrawn.

Since notice of motion was issued by this Court vide order dated 17.10.2016 on the basis of statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, which has now been withdrawn, the main case which is fixed for 17.11.2016, is taken on Board.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of FIR No.288 dated 11.8.2016 under Sections 406/420/467/468/471/120-B IPC registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt., District Ambala.

Since the FIR was registered on 11.8.2016, it can safely be presumed that the police must be investigating the matter. Therefore, the present petition is totally premature and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.
