The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 36 dated 31.03.2016, registered under Sections 363, 366-A IPC and Section 12 POCSO Act (Section 3-33-89 of SC/ST Act added later on), Women Police Station Palwal, District Palwal.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 07.05.2016 and he is the uncle of Sakir. The counsel further states that Sakir and Mena had approached the High court for protection and they had got married on 25.03.2016 and the only allegation against the petitioner is that he had helped Sakir in abducting the girl.

The State counsel states that neither the girl has been recovered nor Sakir has been arrested and earlier also there is a FIR by the complainant against Sakir.

Mena and Sakir had approached the High Court for protection and order (Annexure P-4) was passed on 05.04.2016. It had been claimed there that they had got married against the wishes of the parents on 25.03.2016.

The trial will take long time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
