Petitioner seeks regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Raj Kumar alleging that he had asked his nephew Anil Kumar to take a vehicle towards village Bhariwas and carry 150 boxes of liquor. The said car was, as per statement of nephew made to the complainant, was taken away by 5/6 persons. Allegations against the petitioner is that he along with Sandeep and Ashok had robbed liquor from the nephew of the complainant.

Co-accused of the petitioner namely, Sandeep and Ashok have been granted the concession of bail. Since the recovery has already been effected, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail on the principle of parity. It is also not out of place to mention here that report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C has already been presented.

Petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
