SNEH PRASHAR, J.

The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No. 415 dated 24.08.2016 registered under Sections 379,411,420,472 and 473 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner in compliance with the order dated 10.10.2016 has joined the investigation and nothing remains to be recovered from him.

On instructions from HC Avtar Singh, the learned State counsel has conceded the said fact. He further informs that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required as nothing remains to be recovered from him.
