The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, in FIR No.96 dated 08.07.2015, registered under Section 399 and 402 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at P.S. Sadar Mansa.

On 12.10.2016, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was granted regular bail and thereafter it was cancelled on 01.09.2016, when the non-bailable warrants issued on 04.08.2016 remained unexecuted. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that on 04.08.2016, the petitioner was in custody in some other case.

Notice of motion for 26.10.2016.

Petitioner is directed to appear before the

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trial Court on 21.10.2016 and in the event of his appearance, trial Court shall admit the petitioner on interim bail subject to its satisfaction.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that order dated 12.10.2016, stands complied with.

In view of the above statement, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, order dated 12.10.2016, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
