Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
by Samreet Kaur and Malkiat Singh-petitioners seeking issuance of
direction to respondents No. 1 to 4 to conduct a fair and impartial
investigation in the complaint dated October 07, 2015 (Annexure P-5)
moved by them, by an officer not below the rank of Assistant Commissioner

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of Police.

Pursuant to notice of motion, reply has been filed by the officials respondents No.1 to 4 in the shape of affidavit of Pankhuri Kumar, HPS Assistant Commissioner of Police, Ambala.

According to which, the representation/complaint dated October 07, 2015 (Annexure P-5) has already been enquired into and no substance was found in the allegations levelled in the representation/complaint, the same has ordered to be filed. However, petitioners have been provided supervisory protection by local police, as and when required by the petitioners.

In view of the reply furnished by the learned State counsel, instant petition has rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, petitioners shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available to them under law. Further, respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Ambala is directed to provide the necessary security, if it comes to the conclusion that there is a threat perception to their lives and liberty of the petitioners, as and when any such application is moved.
