Petitioner is a Lambardar who allegedly identified Sadhu Singh as grandson of Nihal Singh, despite the fact that he was grandson of Dayal Singh, at the time of getting mutation sanctioned in favour of Sadhu Singh.

The petitioner has been in custody with effect from 26.07.2016. It has been informed that the co-accused is ready to satisfy the claim of the complainant. Challan having already been presented and the petitioner being in custody since 26.07.2016, he can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
