Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner during pendency of trial in case FIR No.149 dated 19.7.2016, under Section 379-B of IPC and Section 21/22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Cantonment, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is no allegation that any contraband was ever recovered from the petitioner. The only allegation against the petitioner is that he snatched a mobile phone from the complainant. Even otherwise, the FSL Report in the case has not yet been received. The petitioner is in custody since 20.7.2016 and there is no other case against him.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate and fairly states that the FSL Report is awaited and the allegation against the petitioner is that he had snatched the mobile from the complainant.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

There is no allegation against the petitioner that the contraband was recovered from his possession. The only allegation against the petitioner is that he had snatched a mobile phone from the complainant. The petitioner is in custody since 20.7.2016. Since the challan has not been presented, the trial will take sufficient long time. Accordingly, the petition is **accepted**. The petitioner is admitted on regular bail on furnishing of his bail bonds and surety bonds subject to satisfaction of the trial Court.
