This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to provide adequate and appropriate security to the petitioner and her family members, who are facing constant and imminent threats on account of registration of the FIR No. 13 dated 16.9.2015 under Sections 376 and 506 IPC, registered at Women Police Station, Rohtak.

On notice, reply has been filed by the respondents stating that after registration of the FIR, investigation was carried out and date of birth of the petitioner was found as 10.8.1995 and not as 15.8.1997. Even the allegation of the petitioner that she has become pregnant, has been found false when she was got medico legally examined by the Investigating Officer. On further investigation, nothing was found incriminating against the accused and as such, cancellation report has since been forwarded by the SHO, Women Police Station, Rohtak to the higher authorities. It has also come out during

investigation that the petitioner and her family members had entered into a written compromise by getting ₹ 5 lakhs from the family of accused Sandeep son of Ramesh.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, no further direction is required to be given. The petition is accordingly disposed of.
