Report dated 11.02.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Hoshiarpur has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Darshpreet Singh as well as of complainant Sandeep Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the parties belong to the same very village and have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.150 dated 01.10.2008 under Sections 452,323,324,148,149 IPC Police Station, Tanda, District

Hoshiarpur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
