FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 25.09.2015 sent by learned Illaqa Magistrate/Judicial Magistrate 1st Class Panchkula has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Neeraj Kumar and Sandeep Kumar as well as of complainant Navjot Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052,** FIR No.164 dated 31.07.2013 under Sections 406,420,506,34 IPC Police Station, Sector 14 Panchkula and all other consequential

proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
