JASPAL SINGH, J.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.70, dated 23.04.2010, under Sections 386, 506, 508 and 34 IPC, Police Station Sadar Rupnagar, District Rupnagar (Annexure P-1), along with all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 27.09.2014 (Annexure P-5).

2. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise so effected between the parties is genuine. Even otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. So, in view of above circumstances, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, the instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.70, dated 23.04.2010, under Sections 386, 506, 508 and 34 IPC, Police Station Sadar Rupnagar, District Rupnagar alongwith all other consequential proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
