By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.0072 dated 28.05.2016, registered under Section 306 read with Section 34 of IPC, at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

On 17.10.2016, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that immediately after the death of Vishal Deep Singh @ Paras, uncle of the deceased made a statement indicating no foul play was suspected. The petitioner is the wife of the deceased and was minor at that time. Ingredients of Section 306 of Indian Penal Code are not made out.

Notice of motion 06.12.2016.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, she shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

- 1.That she shall make herself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- 2.That she shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;*
- 3.That she shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”*

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 17.10.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation

The learned State counsel, on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 17.10.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
