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**DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)**

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 5 to take action against private respondents as the petitioner has been cheated and her husband is going to solemnize second marriage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with the efforts made by the petitioner, the earlier marriage fixed for 26.01.2016 was postponed but very soon, the marriage is going to be solemnized. Learned counsel also submits that the petitioner has not only been cheated but a fraud has also been played with her. The petitioner made a representation (Annexure P-7) to the police authorities but no action has been taken thereupon so far.

Heard the arguments of learned counsel for the petitioner and

have also perused the documents available on the file.

The remedy available with the petitioner is to make complaint to the concerned authorities i.e Station House Officer of the concerned Police Station. In this petition, disputed issues have been raised, as to whether a direction can be issued to respondent No.2 not to get the marriage solemnized by respondent No.5. *Ex-parte* divorce has also been obtained by respondent No.6. The petitioner is having remedy to challenge the *ex-parte* decree.

No ground is made out to issue any direction.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to move a complaint to the concerned Police Station.
