Petitioner seeks interim bail in case FIR No.12 dated 15.2.2013 under Sections 302/ 452/ 148/ 149/ 506/ 216 IPC registered at Police Station Nathu Sari Chopta District Sirsa on the ground that his father has expired on 1.10.2016 and his presence is necessary on 13th day of death i.e. kirya ceremony.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Gurdas Singh Sarwara, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let a copy of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes

to pass there is no necessity of filing reply at this stage.

Evidently, petitioner was sent to attend cremation on 1.10.2016 in police custody. Keeping in view the nature of offence and stage of trial, it would be just and expedient to allow the petitioner to attend *kirya ceremony* on 13.10.2016 in police custody.

Accordingly, Jail Superintendent, Sirsa is directed to depute requisite number of police officials with the petitioner on 13.10.2016 at 9.00 A.M for attending the kirya ceremony and after its completion, the petitioner shall be brought back to the jail premises. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sirsa is also directed to monitor the schedule of visit of the petitioner to the place of kirya ceremony and ensure the return of the petitioner to the jail premises in police custody after doing the needful.

Petition stands disposed of.
