This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.84 dated 27.5.2015 under sections 22, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

Suffice it to notice that as per prosecution version an alleged recovery of 253 grams of Diacetylmorphine was effected from the petitioner.

The alleged recovery is marginally over and above the commercial quantity which for such salt is 250 grams.

It has gone uncontroverted that the petitioner is not involved in any other proceedings under the N.D.P.S Act.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Hoshiarpur.

Petition disposed of.
