The petitioners seek protection to their life and liberty from the private respondents No.6 and 7 on account of their marriage which has been conducted on 08.10.2016 at Pracheen Shri Shiv Mandir, Panchkula.

The copy of marriage certificate is appended as Annexure P-3 and photographs as Annexure P-4. It has been averred in the petition that date of birth of petitioner no. 1 is 05.03.1998 as per the Secondary Examination Certificate (Annexure P-1), whereas date of birth of petitioner No. 2 is 01.12.1994 as per Secondary Examination Certificate (Annexure P-2).

Petitioner No.2 is stated to be running his transport business at Gurgaon and thus, he is in a position to carry on the family life in good atmosphere. The talks of marriage of the petitioners were going on but the private respondents had objected to the same. On account of apprehension of threats, the petitioners moved a

representation dated 10.10.2016 (Annexure P/5) to the Superintendent of Police, Hisar, Haryana (respondent No.2)

After hearing counsel for the petitioners; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and without commenting upon the validity of the marriage or the age of the petitioners and keeping in view the binding precedent of the ***Hon'ble Apex Court in Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478***, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondents no. 2 to 4 to look into the above said representation filed by the petitioners with respondent no. 2 and take necessary action in accordance with law and provide protection, if so required.
