INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner, Paramjit Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.188 dated 19.09.2016, registered at Police station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur, under Sections 341, 323, 324, 382 and 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that the present petitioner has neither been named in the FIR nor stated to be armed with any weapon. No injury has been attributed to him. Rather, he has been nominated by complainant in the supplementary statement.

In pursuance of the order dated 18.10.2016, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is now not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 18.10.2016 passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
