The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 43 dated 30.03.2012 registered under Sections 323, 324, 325, 452 and 506 read with Section 34 I.P.C. at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar, on the basis of compromise, which was registered at the instance of respondent No. 2, namely Balkar Singh, alleging that petitioner No. 1 and 2 had inflicted injuries on the person of

the complainant with spade and baseball bat.

The parties were directed to appear before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Baba Bakala Sahib, and make statement regarding the compromise. After recording the statements, a report has been received that the matter has been compromised voluntarily, without any threat, coercion or inducement.

I am satisfied that the case of assault of year 2012 has been amicably resolved.

Following the Full Bench judgment of this Court in Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the FIR can be quashed in the present case. The petition is accordingly allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
