By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner has sought the concession of bail, pending trial, in case bearing FIR No.31 dated 29.04.2015, under Sections 420, 408, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Division 6, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Concededly, petitioner was arrested in this case on 19th July, 2016 and after subjecting him custodial interrogation, he was remanded to judicial custody, meaning thereby, he was no more required by the Investigating Agency for further interrogation. Even otherwise, on conclusion of the investigation, report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. has already been presented, the disposal thereof, is likely to take sufficient long time. There is another material aspect that after filing of the instant petition, parties have patched up the matter and the compromise arrived at between them has been put into black and white, the photocopy of which,

has been presented by learned counsel for the petitioner today which is made a part of this file.

Taking into consideration all these aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on merits, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds as per the satisfaction of concerned ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
