Petitioner Rajinder Kumar has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 65 dated 11.06.2016, under Sections 376 and 506 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Dehlon, District Ludhiana.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Arshdeep S. Kler, DAG, Punjab has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested the bail application. Custody certificate has been filed by him, in which it is shown that the accused has undergone 4 months and 26 days as on 11.11.2016. It is also submitted that statement of the prosecutrix under Section 164 Cr.P.C. has been recorded.

In view of the fact that statement of the prosecutrix has been recorded and the accused-petitioner has already undergone 4 months and 26 days as on today and further that the trial is likely to take some time, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody furthermore.

Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without expressing any opinion on the merit of the case, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/learned trial Court concerned.

Petition stands disposed of.
