INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in cross-version of FIR No.74 dated 08.05.2016, registered at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda, under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 and 34 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on).

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the statement of Jaspreet Singh, complainant in the cross-version, the present petitioner was armed with sword and gave its blow on the head of Jaspreet Singh. The said injury has been declared grievous.

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Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the facts that the present petitioner is required for custodial interrogation and sword is yet to be recovered from him, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
