By filing the present petition, under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No. 12 dated 29.02.2016, registered under Sections 395, 323 and 324 of IPC, at Police Station Ghuman Kalan, District Gurdaspur.

It is contended that only simple injuries have been attributed to the petitioner. The similarly situated co-accused, Ravinder Singh @ Yadwinder Singh has been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court, vide order dated 11.08.2016. The petitioner is in custody since 20.07.2016.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused

the record.

Considering the fact that injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature; he is in custody since 20.07.2016; the challan stands presented; charges have been framed; therefore, it can safely be inferred that the trial is not likely to be concluded in the near future, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Anything said herein above shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
